- ☐ Name of person, date of birth and date of death.
- Describe the person's early life (childhood).
  - 3-5 interesting facts in paragraph format about the individual growing up, this may be their family or education etc.
- Explain how the person came to a position of power.
- Describe and assess the contribution the person made to society in Ancient China and/or the Modern world.
   Include what the person is famous for.
  - What was their contribution to China and other societies/ what is the individual famous for?
     I.e. The Mongol Empire
  - o Has the person made a great contribution or a small contribution to society?
  - Give reasons for your answer.
